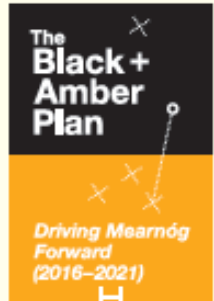




Update meeting Friday 3rd March @8pm

There are 215 distinct groups within the club. All of these have been included in the research plan.



Over 350 online surveys have been completed.

2000+

We have over 2,000 feedback comments from the research.



Over 110+ people attended the townhall, at which over 440 suggestions were given on how to improve the club.



We have analysed past, current, and future populations data for the club's geographical area.



The strategy committee has conducted over 25 interviews/focus groups, with more to come.
